We employ painters from the Painters and Allied Trades International Union. Union membership includes full health insurance and retirement benefits. Being a Journeyman painter is not just a job, it is a career with opportunity to work on some of the biggest projects in the city.

Painter wages range from apprentice level starting at \$18.33 to Journeyman \$30.55 up to \$32.55 for an elite Foreman! Fringe benefits including health insurance and retirement add an extra \$11.95 per hour to your income. Drug test and proof that you qualify to work in the United States required (Social Security, Passport, Green Card).

APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM (no experience necessary)

The regional union office runs the Finishing Trades Institute which provides ongoing training and a variety of safety programs. These classes provide you skills for success – all while working at a high wage job. These programs will advance your career and establish you as a professional ready to meet any challenge on the jobsite. The Painter's apprenticeship is a 4 year program consisting of 8,000 hours on the job training and 144 hours of trade related classroom instruction per year.
